 can buy used!
- Environmentally Conscious Choice
- Can use with multiple kids
- Have resale value
- Available in different styles
- Flexible Absorbency
- One Size Adjustable from birth to potty training

Cons to cloth diapering

- Can be smelly compared to disposables
- Increased Laundry
 - Washing instructions can be scary
 find what works for you!!
- Can be more difficult to travel with
 - Don't be afraid to use disposables when out and about

Cloth Diapering: Is it for Your Family?

- Less chemical/more natural approach
- Good for kids with sensitive skin
- Cute Patterns/Designs
- More comfortable than plastic disposables
- No Blow-Outs!
- Potty Trains sooner
- Diaper Services are available
- Cloth diapering comes with a support network!!
 - Disposables can be more convenient!
 - The fit of cloth diapers can vary from kid to kid
 - Daycares might not accept cloth diapering
 - Learning curve to cloth diapering!
 - Reduced absorbency compared to disposables
